
Get a Card & Borrow

All Topsfield residents are eligible to get a library card; apply at our Circulation Desk or online! We are members of the Merrimack Valley Library Consortium (MVLC). Your card is good at 36 libraries across the MVLC; request items via our online catalog to be sent to Topsfield for pickup. Libby by Overdrive allows you to download ebooks, audiobooks, and more. Download the free Libby app on your device, and log in with your library card to read on your phone, tablet, or Kindle.

Kanopy is a streaming video site available through the library; you can browse over 30,000 movies to watch on your phone, computer, or TV.

The library offers free online access to the **New York Times** and **Wall Street Journal**, and databases like **Global Road Warrior**, and **Comics Plus**.

Use genealogical tools like **Ancestry.com Library Edition** (in-library) or **Heritage Quest** from home.
